WiserEarth is a free **international non-profit directory** and **networking forum** for organizations and individuals addressing the central issues of our day: conservation, climate change, poverty, peace, water, hunger, social justice, human rights, and more. Content is created by people like you from around the world.

WiserEarth includes extensive information around the field of conservation. The Biodiversity Conservation Portal, for example, links close to 2,000 people and more than 4,000 organizations around this central theme. Connected to this portal are 105 community groups, 221 resources, and 186 events.

Visit WiserEarth to ...

- **Create** an easy to manage **online group** to coordinate a project team or conservation network.
- **Search for conservation NGOs** around the world by key word or location
- Post your profile and **connect with people** in other regions doing similar work
- **Announce your events** and stay current with what's happening in the field
- **Share key documents, toolkits or manuals** using the Conservation Pages

Online Groups:

Create private or public groups where you can connect, collaborate, share knowledge, and build alliances around your conservation strategies and networks. In as little as 30 minutes you can have a professional, dynamic, and easy to maintain website. Specific features of interest might include:

- **Privacy** can be set to only allow members to view content (private), allow members to edit content and anyone to view it (semi-private), and totally public (anyone can edit or view)
- **Access to join groups** can be by invitation only, by referral of an existing member, open to apply, or anyone can join
- **Layout and content is easily customizable** – tiles with different group content can be moved around the window into your preferred position, and you can pick and choose which tile types to use.
- **Group content can be reused** – if you want you, can share materials between groups making it easy to administer multiple groups which share similar aims.
- **Every change to a group is backed-up** – you can revert to an earlier version of content with a few mouse-clicks.
